BUFFALO TO OPEN SECOND EMERSON SCHOOL OF HOSPITALITY BCSA Administrators Plan for Move to Historic Site

The process for choosing a site to transform into the second Emerson School of Hospitality was long and complicated. The goal was to be located in the downtown area near the successful and popular original Emerson High School of Hospitality. A 15-year lease was finally signed with the developer of the C. W. Miller Livery Stable historic property. The school will house a restaurant, private dining room, banquet hall, special events center, kitchen, bakery, food prep and serving area in addition to classrooms and a gym. The school is targeted to move from the current annex in South Buffalo to the C. W. Miller site in the downtown tourist corridor for opening in September 2020.

Principal Debbie-White Stokes and Assistant Principals Kathleen Schuta and Elena Wozniak have had the responsibility of administering the current high school along with the annex. These BCSA members are involved in the exciting work of creating a new Emerson School of Hospitality at a historic site in the architecturally rich center of Buffalo.
